

RWTH International Academy – German Language Scholarship

Rules detailing the examination for the *RWTH International Academy Scholarship for Advanced German Language Education*

Preamble

The Scholarship was established in cooperation with the Language Centre of the RWTH Aachen University to support students in the continuation of their language studies even after successfully passing the DSM exam. It is intended for students who are enrolled at the RWTH Aachen University in one of the following two Master's degree programmes:

M.Sc. Computer Aided Conception and Production in Mechanical Engineering
M.Sc. Production Systems Engineering.

§ 1 Principles

The scholarship covers the fees for the participation in one continuing German language course of the RWTH Aachen Language Centre (with two or four hours per week) in the semester directly after the DSM exam has been completed successfully. An intensive German course of eight hours per week is not covered by this scholarship.

§ 2 Required Qualification of the students

Enrolled students of the programmes mentioned above who have passed the DSM examination with a minimum mark of 2,0 are eligible for this scholarship. Students exempted from the DSM on the basis of a Goethe Certificate (B1 or higher) with a minimum mark of 2,0 and a minimum score of 80% in each test section, are also eligible.

§ 3 Registration Process

After taking the DSM exam, eligible students will be informed by the RWTH International Academy and need to register independently on the website of the RWTH Aachen Language Centre for the German language course of their choice. Students exempted from the DSM on the basis of a Goethe Certificate need to undergo a placement test at the Language Centre to verify their B1 level before the scholarship comes into effect.

§ 4 Escape clause

The awarding of this scholarship is dependent on the availability of the financial capital of the RWTH International Academy student fund. There is no legal basis for students to demand the scholarship.
