

## RWTH International Academy – German Language Scholarship

Rules detailing the examination for the *RWTH International Academy Scholarship for Advanced German Language Education*

### Preamble

The Scholarship was established in cooperation with the Language Centre of the RWTH Aachen University to support students in the continuation of their German Language studies. It applies to students of the following Master's degree programmes:

**M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Computer Aided Mechanical Engineering**  
**M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Design Concepts and Structural Engineering of Industrial Facilities**  
**M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Production Systems**  
**M.Sc. Management and Engineering in Water**

### § 1 Principles

The scholarship covers the fees for the participation in one additional German language course of the RWTH Aachen Language Centre, which can be taken after the completion of the mandatory A1.1 course. It enables the participation in a course during the semester with two or four hours per week. This applies to students, who attended the intensive course at the RWTH Language Centre and passed it with a minimum mark of 1,3.

### § 2 Required Qualification of the students

Enrolled students of the above-mentioned programmes who have passed the A1.1 level successfully (with a minimum mark of 1,3 in the German grading system).

### § 3 Registration Process

Eligible students will be contacted by the RWTH International Academy. Afterwards, these students need to register independently on the RWTH Aachen Language Centre's website for the German language course of their choice. The registration dates will be announced.

### § 4 Escape clause

The awarding of this scholarship is dependent on the availability of the financial capital of the RWTH International Academy student fund. There is no legal basis for students to demand the scholarship.
