CAME: Internship Completion (1)

- How to find an Internship

- Students are Self-Responsible to find an Internship
- We recommend to search six months in advance
- Your application documents can be checked from the Master Office Staff as a support service
- Search options are summarized here:

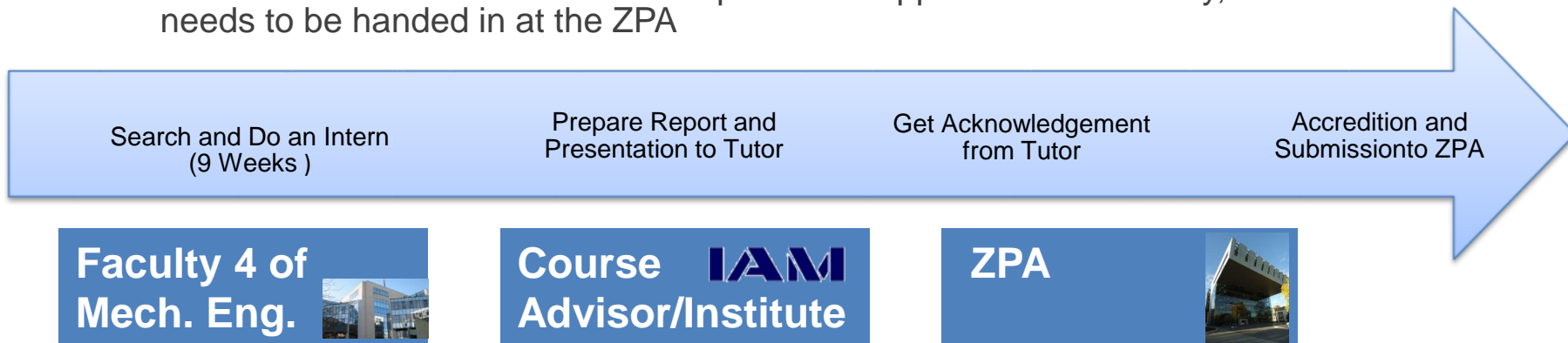

- Attention!

- Interns have to be done only in industrial companies
- Interns cannot be done at university institutes, research-institutes
- In case of doubts, contact the internship office in advance!
- A confirmation that the internship is compulsory can be requested from the internship office on the website of the faculty [here](#)

CAME: Internship Completion (2)

- Scope
 - Minimum of 9 weeks to be completed upon registration of master thesis
- Report & Presentation:
 - Collect acknowledgment form at faculty 4's internship office
 - 2 DIN A4 pages per week, to be handed in at the tutor (a Professor of Faculty 4// CAME Prof. Markert/Mr- Shehadeh) as well as a presentation
 - Tutor acknowledges the intern with the certificate form
- Work certificate:
 - Needs to be provided by the company itself
- Accrediation of the faculty:
 - Based on the work certificate and report. After approval of the faculty, the certificate needs to be handed in at the ZPA



CAME: Internship „Waiver“

- Present work experience certificate to internship office to get an acknowledgment form
- Give a presentation on your work to the tutor (IAM) and receive an acknowledgment certificate
- Get accreditation from internship office and submit it to ZPA
